Top 5 Most Supported Policy Recommendations

1	Improve the quality of care (including better food, increased personal hygiene and more hours of care)	Fixing Long-Term Care	98% Approval*
2	Create and protect green space and increase Ontario's tree canopy	Fighting Climate Change and Protecting our Environment	97% Approval*
3	Move to a full-time staffing model in long-term care, providing more stability, better working conditions, higher wages and more accountability	Fixing Long-Term Care	96% Approval*
4	Reverse the gutting of Conservation Authorities and provide them with the tools they need to deliver on their mandate	Fighting Climate Change and Protecting Our Environment	96% Approval*
5	Improve emission performance standards for big polluters	Fighting Climate Change and Protecting Our Environment	96% Approval*






WEEK #2: Economic Dignity

TOP COMMENTED ON POLICY STATEMENTS RELATED TO ECONOMIC DIGNITY

- Raise minimum wage to \$17/hr by 2026 (594 comments)
- Increase tax credits for kids sports and extracurricular activities (519)
- Introduce a targeted basic income, including for people with disabilities (507)
- Create a new tax bracket for ultra-high income earners who make more than one million dollars per year (506)

[RE: increased Ontario Works benefit] Guaranteed basic income instead! (6 Likes)

This [increased Ontario Works benefit] should be replaced with a basic income. (6 Likes)

[RE: new ultra-rich tax bracket] Close tax loopholes, and charge the upper levels of income earners. It is the duty of those who have, to help those who don't. Look at places like Norway. (5 Likes)

[RE: new ultra-rich tax bracket] Taxes should be on an increasing scale, just as it is. What we need to do is close the loopholes that allow tax evasion (5 Likes)

[RE:CPP to-up] Universal basic income. Solves this and the gig economy. (5 Likes)

[RE: tax credits for extracurriculars] We need to return to an educational curriculum which includes a period of physical education daily. Tax credits do not allow all children to participate (5 Likes)

[RE: raise minimum wage] Commit to raising the minimum wage to keep up with the cost of living! That may be higher than \$17 in 5 years time. (5 Likes)
