Dear Premier Ford,

I am writing to you as an opposition leader, on behalf of the nearly 15 million people who call Ontario home.

We are a resilient bunch, as you would surely know after two years of this pandemic. But for all the strength we have as a province, there is only so much inaction we can take.

In March 2020, the world was blindsided by COVID-19. Nobody, myself included, could blame you for a situation that got out of hand quickly. We supported your efforts to get us through the first wave and made positive recommendations whenever we could.

But we aren't in the first wave anymore, nor the second, third or fourth. Premier, we are in the fifth wave, still repeating the same mistakes made more than a year ago.

We still haven't repealed the anti-nurse, wage-capping Bill 124, that has been driving nurses and other healthcare professionals out of the field in droves. There still aren't adequate mental health supports for those working on the frontlines in hospitals and nursing homes. Ontario workers still don't have access to ten days of paid sick leave. Ontario has no plan for keeping nurses and personal support workers in their field. We need a Health Human Resources Strategy urgently or the crisis in healthcare will only continue to get worse.

It is unacceptable that nearly two years into a public health crisis, you haven't been able to build enough hospital staffing capacity to withstand, not the first or second, but the fifth wave of this pandemic. Hospitals declaring "Code Orange" - a disaster that threatens to overwhelm them - this far into the crisis is shameful.

Your inaction has also caused schools and businesses to close for longer than in any other jurisdiction in North America. It has taken an immense toll on the mental health and
