

**NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING
OF THE ONTARIO YOUNG LIBERALS**

SEPTEMBER 20 - 22, 2024, LONDON

In accordance with Article 13 of the Constitution of the Ontario Young Liberals (OYL), NOTICE is hereby given of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the OYL to elect its Executive Board and to conduct the annual business of the OYL.

Date and Location

Friday September 20, 2024, afternoon, to Sunday September 22, 2024, afternoon.

RBC Place London, 300 York St, London.

Registration

Everyone who has registered for the Ontario Liberal Party (OLP) AGM that is under the age of 26 at the time of the OLP annual meeting, will automatically be deemed to have registered for the OYL AGM.

One must be a registered attendee of the OLP AGM to attend the OYL AGM.

Early Bird Registration Fees (paid prior to 11:59pm on Friday August 23)

Youth (14-25 on Sep 20)	\$105
Student (must also be 14-25 on Sep 20)	\$90

Registration Fees (paid after early bird rates end on Friday August 23)

Youth (14-25 on Sep 20)	\$165
Student (must also be 14-25 on Sep 20)	\$140

Membership

Everyone who registers and pays the OLP AGM registration fee that is not a current member of the OLP, will automatically be registered for a membership in the OLP, unless they register at the non-member (Observer) rate.

Attending the Annual Meeting as a Voting Delegate

Everyone who registers shall automatically be deemed to have submitted an intent notice to stand for a voting delegate position, unless the person qualifies for an ex-officio delegate position or registers as a non-member Observer.

All intent notices (registrations) submitted prior to 11:59pm on Friday August 2 shall have equal standing in contention for the available delegate positions in the relevant affiliated association, such as a constituency association, student club, or women's club.

If an affiliated association has more intent notices submitted prior to 11:59pm on Friday August 2 than available delegate positions, the Returning Officer shall follow the procedure in section 5.3 of the OLP Rules of Procedure for Annual Meetings, including potentially scheduling a Delegate Election Vote for the affiliated association.

After Friday August 2, unfilled affiliated association delegate positions shall be filled in chronological order of registration.

Important to note that the number of accredited delegates and alternates for student clubs is different between the OLP AGM (5 voting delegates per student club) and the OYL AGM (15 voting delegates per student club). Therefore, it is possible that a person could be a voting delegate from a student club for the OYL AGM, but only an alternate for the OLP AGM.

Election of OYL Executive Board Officers

Pursuant to section 3.5 of the OLP Rules of Procedure for Commissions, any person who wishes to seek election at the annual meeting as an officer must, on or before 11:59pm on Friday August 30, deliver written notice by sending an email to returningofficer@ontarioliberal.ca. Such notice must include:

1. The person's name, residential address, email address, and telephone number.
2. Such other address of the person seeking to be nominated to which they prefer notices and communications to be mailed or delivered.
3. The telephone number at which the person seeking to be nominated or their agent can be reached during ordinary business hours.
4. The office for which such person seeks nomination.
5. The riding(s) in which they hold membership in the Ontario Liberal Party.

A candidate for the office of Regional Coordinator must reside in the region a majority of the time and must provide proof of residence at the AGM.
